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Case study - 1

Mr. Suresh, who has completed his post-graduation in management in one of the reputed institutes in India, would like to start his own business. He is more concerned about environment and other issues like pollution which are suffering the health of people in India. Hence, he is thinking of starting a green company which is manufacturing green products. Unfortunately, there is no much demand for green products in India at present, but he would like to go-ahead in this regard. **Ouestions:**

(a) Suggest Mr. Suresh about the following:

- (i) Sources of financing green company.
- (ii) Environmental laws in brief.
- (iii) Demand for green products.

Case study - 2

Mr. Naresh is an young entrepreneur and more enthusiastic about starting a new type of business in India. He thought of establishing green company assuming that there is a lot of demand for green products. He is also worried about the present problem of pollution and ecological imbalances and hence strongly decided to start green company. But he needs your advises on the issues. **Ouestions:**

(a) Are there any financial sources to support the green companies in India?

(b) What are the Govt. regulations with regard to establishing of green companies?

(c) Do you support the decision of Mr. Naresh in this regard? If not, what are your suggestions?

Case study - 3

ABC town was well known for its hosiery industry. This is actually a conglomeration of a variety of industries like knitting, embroidery, dyeing, etc. The industry has grown by leaps and bounds and represents a major share of Indian hosiery exports. But recently the pollution norms necessitated the treatment of the effluent water from the dyeing industry due to presence of heavy metals in the reactive dyes used by the industries. This led to the closure of some dyeing units who did not have treatment plants for the water. This business also shifted out of the city to neighboring cities and some cities in North India. Till recently most industries had no knowledge about the impact of these industries on the environment and most of them had other pressing problems on hand like a constantly shifting labour force that needed a lot of skilling to compete to compete with Chinese industries, and frequent power cuts leading the use of diesel generators that cost four times the power cost from the electricity board. In the middle of so many issues, most companies are confused on what to do as regards sustainability. If you are to advice the firms in this city, what will you suggest to have green business practices implemented in the firms there?

Case study – 4

Muruga temple is one of the ancient temples for Lord Karthikeva, suited on a hill in Tamilnadu. Every year this temple receives scores of pilgrims. Along the crowds, the temple authorities also noticed environmental issues. On the sides of the temple, one finds increasing dumps of plastic and other indestructible rubbish. Added to that is use of plastic in every shop. When crowds come in, there are a number of hawkers who have set up shop. These shops have also resulted in growth in local tribal settlements neat the temple. Added to this is disposal of excess food that is prepared every day to feed the pilgrims. On the whole, the entire environment is showing signs of degradation, which if neglected will result in a spoiled eco system. The temple management is looking to rectify this situation using green management practices. If you are to help the temple management, what practices do you suggest to ensure a good eco system in and around the temple?
