
2. Andhra Pradesh – 517583 through RTGS.
3. The Institute is requested to verify the correctness of the under mentioned bank account/RTGS submitted by them along with the proposals, in which the grant is being released. In case of any omission the same should be reported to AICTE immediately along with refund of entire grant.

4. The date of release of the grant by AICTE shall be taken as the date of commencement of the project. The Principal shall intimate about the receipt of the grant to AICTE. Any expenditure incurred prior to the issuance of the approval letter will not be allowed to be adjusted in the grant and if the Institution/ University do not take the project within 6 months of the receipt of the grant, the approval shall ipso facto lapse.
5. Each project sanctioned by AICTE is assigned a specific Ref. No. given on the pre-page. All correspondences related to the project must contain this number along with year of sanction of the project; failing which correspondence will not be entertained.
6. The accounts of the grantee which are liable to be audited by the Council or Comptroller and Audited General of India or by any Officer designated for the purpose.
7. The institute shall not charge any overheads on this project and will provide all the administrative support for completion of the project.
8. The grantee shall utilize grants on only approved items of expenditure (list enclosed). **Approval is accorded to the institutes to procure items listed in the scheme document (as per the requirement of the Center) in addition to the already approved list of items/equipment sent to the institute, so that the grant under non-recurring head may be fully utilized by the institute.** They will maintain proper accounts of the expenditure as per the norms/procedures of AICTE/Government of India.
9. The assets acquired wholly or substantially out of All India Council for Technical Education's grant shall not be disposed or encumbered or utilize for the purpose other than those for which the Grant was given without proper sanction of the All India Council for Technical Education and should at any time the institution cease to function, such assets shall revert to the All India Council for Technical Education.
10. The grantee shall maintain an audited record of assets acquired wholly or substantially out of the grant-in-aid and a register or assets shall be maintained by the Institute in the prescribed form i.e. GFR-19.
11. The Amount of interest accrued on the grant should be treated as part of the grant to be utilized for that particular project. However, the interest amount accrued along with grant disbursed should not exceed the total grant sanctioned for the project. The Institute receiving the grant should reflect the same in the audited statement of accounts/ Utilization Certificate and may either refund the interest amount to AICTE or AICTE should adjust the same in the next installment of grant before releasing.
12. The Annual Progress Report in the prescribed format along with Statement of Expenditure and Audited Utilization Certificate shall be submitted to AICTE not later than one month after completion.
13. Project Completion Report (PCR) in the prescribed format along with the Audited Statement of Expenditure indicating expenditure incurred in the total duration of the project in the prescribed format, utilization in the format and GFR-19 shall be submitted to the Council.

14. The Utilization Certificate (UC) supported by Audited Statement of Expenditure to the effect that the grant has been utilized for the purpose for which it has been sanctioned shall be furnished to the All India Council for Technical Education immediately after completion of the project. It should contain the head-wise break up of expenditure made from the grant-in-aid provided by the Council.
15. The grantee shall follow the terms and conditions of Skill and Personality Development Programme Centre for SC/ST Students (SPDC) as laid down by the council from time to time.
16. The Grantee shall fully implement the official language policy of Union Government and comply with the official language Act, 1963 and official language (use of official purposes of the Union Rules, 1976 etc.)
17. The Institute receiving grant under SPDC is expected to put up a plaque at the main entrance of the Lab/Department, which has been modernized using the grant. All the equipment procured through the project should be superscribed with AICTE project file number.
18. The funds to the extent are available under the scheme.
19. The sanction issues in exercise of the powers delegated to the Council. It is also certified that grant-in-aid is being released in conformity with the Rules and Regulation of the scheme.

Procedure for Release of the Financial Support:

- ⇒ As an important post-accreditation quality sustenance activity, NAAC has requested the institutions to establish Internal Quality Assurance Cell (IQAC) in their institution. Hence organization of the seminar/workshop is mandated to be the activity of IQAC of the Institution.
- ⇒ The programme details of seminar/conference have to be sent to NAAC at least one month prior to the scheduled dates.
- ⇒ The sanctioned amounts should be spent exclusively on the programme for which the assistance is approved by NAAC.
- ⇒ **The release of grants will be on completion of the event and submission of the bills/vouchers/Statement of expenditure and Utilizations Certificate within a month to NAAC.** In case of any delay in submission of the claims the reimbursement will not be made and NAAC will not be liable for the expenditure incurred.
- ⇒ For better coordination organisers should be in communication with the respective Regional Coordinator at NAAC.
- ⇒ *The seminar/workshop has to be conducted on the scheduled date(s) as mentioned in the seminar proposals sent to NAAC. You have to obtain prior permission from NAAC if there is any change in the scheduled date of the seminar and state the reason for change of dates.*
- ⇒ *The seminar/workshop has to be conducted on same theme/title as mentioned in the seminar proposals sent to NAAC. You have to obtain prior permission from NAAC if there is any change in the scheduled theme/title of the seminar and state the reason for change of theme/title.*
- ⇒ Institutions may write a letter to the Regional Co-ordinators, NAAC seeking nomination for resource persons.
- ⇒ TA and honorarium for NAAC nominated resource persons and others may be paid within the grant sanctioned by NAAC. **Honorarium of Rs. 2,000/- per day may be paid as per NAAC rule.**
- ⇒ If NAAC officer is participating, the TA/DA may be either borne by NAAC or by the institution from the sanctioned grant. However, hospitality needs to be provided by the institution.
- ⇒ For National Level seminar, institution has to invite at least 10% of participants from outside the state and for State Level Seminar institutions have to invite at least 25% of participants from outside the district.
- ⇒ Institution cannot outsource the activity and as already mentioned the IQAC should be responsible for organising the event.
- ⇒ NAAC should be duly acknowledged in all the seminar related publications including proceedings of the Seminar / Conference.
- ⇒ **Institution need to conduct one session on online A& A methodology in Revised Accreditation Framework.**
- ⇒ List of Participants with communication details should be sent to NAAC along with the proceedings and bills.

Post Seminar/workshop requirement:

Within a week of the seminar the institution should bring out "The Proceedings" of the seminar/conference. A half page summary of the proceedings along with one or two photographs of high resolution may be sent to Regional Co-ordinator, NAAC for considering it for NAAC newsletter.

MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING

between

Siddharth Institute of Engineering & Technology (SIETK)
and
gcGEMS – GC German Center for Engineering and Management Studies UG Aachen
and
European Center for Mechatronics APS GmbH Aachen

This Memorandum of Understanding ("MOU") is executed on the 15th day of February 2019, between:

Siddharth Institute of Engineering & Technology (SIETK) having its principal address at Siddharth Nagar, Narayanavanam Road, Puttur, Chittoor Dt. AP, India. (here in after referred to as "INDIAN UNIVERSITY", which expression shall unless repugnant to the meaning thereof, mean and include its successors and permitted assigns) of the FIRST PART

AND

GC German Center for Engineering and Management Studies , having its principal address at Kapuzinergraben 38, Aachen 52062 Germany (hereinafter referred to as "GEMS", which expression shall unless repugnant to the meaning thereof, mean and include its successors and permitted assigns) of the SECOND PART,

AND

European Center for Mechatronics APS GmbH Aachen, having its principal address at vaalserstrasse 460, 52072 Aachen, Germany (hereinafter referred to as "APS", which expression shall unless repugnant to the meaning thereof, mean and include its successors and permitted assigns) of the THIRD PART,

APS and GEMS collectively referred as European Center for Mechatronics and Manufacturing. (here in after referred to as "ECMM", which expression shall unless repugnant to the meaning thereof, mean and include its successors and permitted assigns)

INDIAN UNIVERSITY and ECMM are individually referred to as "Party" and collectively as the "Parties".

WHEREAS:

A. INDIAN UNIVERSITY is conducting academic courses (B.Tech, M.Sc., MBA and PhD) to students and management courses to professionals in reputed institutions, organizations and individuals in order to train management skills.

- B. GEMS is supporting international research, trainings and academic programs between Germany and India
- C. APS is actively supporting conceptual research, industrial research and academic programs in Germany and globally.
- D. INDIAN UNIVERSITY, GEMS and APS intend to collaborate by entering into an MOU as part of establishing the "European Center for Mechatronics and Manufacturing", in its academic and research part as "Advanced Robotics Labs at Academia": here in after mentioned as "ARC"

In pursuance of the afore said, the Parties hereto wish to record under this MOU, the terms of their mutual understanding in order to establish a framework for initiating innovative models of industry based and cutting edge technical education.

NOW THE PARTIES HERETO AGREE AS UNDER:

ARTICLE 1: SCOPE OF THE MOU

1.1 The objective of this MOU is to set out the scope within which INDIAN UNIVERSITY, GEMS and APS will jointly explore and work towards achieving the objectives and matters described in this MOU. Each Party shall have the right, in its sole discretion, to determine how it will fulfill its obligations hereunder.

- ECMM is co-funding the INDIAN UNIVERSITY for establishing the ARC lab and student trainings along with industry partners and government partners.
- ECMM is providing knowledge transfer, training and industrial connect
- ECMM is executing the faculty training and student training in cooperation with INDIAN UNIVERSITY and Andhra Pradesh Skill Development Corporation (APSSDC)
- ECMM will be providing the course content and execution plan in consultation with APSSDC
- INDIAN UNIVERSITY is a partner to be part of establishing the Indo-European cluster for Mechatronics and Manufacturing
- INDIAN UNIVERSITY to be resource partner in India for ECMM for mutually agreed programs by providing two faculties for this process of ARC labs
- INDIAN UNIVERSITY is assigning the minimum 2 faculties for executing this program in India.
- INDIAN UNIVERSITY will be mobilizing the students and organizing the infrastructure recommended by the ECMM and APSSDC
- Conduct Mechatronics and Manufacturing courses and lab work
- Exchange of researchers and students
- To apply and manage international research projects with Indian and German companies/organizations.
- Establish of a common research location/ representation for transnational research projects between German and Indian partners in Andhra Pradesh

- Collaborate for dissemination of knowledge on cutting edge technologies to faculty and research programs
- GEMS will be the organizing body for the process of this cooperation activity

1.2 If INDIAN UNIVERSITY, GEMS and APS mutually agree to pursue any specific objectives and undertakings, the terms and conditions for pursuing such objectives shall be documented on a case-to-case basis.

ARTICLE 2: ADVISORY GROUP

- 2.1 An "advisory board" is proposed in order to keep up with the rapidly changing trends in technology and academic requirements and to review the working and progress of the collaboration activities.
- 2.2 The board consists of one member from INDIAN UNIVERSITY, GEMS and APS and accomplished academic & industry representatives.
- 2.3 INDIAN UNIVERSITY, GEMS and APS can recommend the names of such representatives.
- 2.4 This board will meet on if needed at a mutually agreed location and will also discuss more frequently through email/electronic media as required to address the aspects related to the collaboration. Meeting are also possible with online conferences.

ARTICLE 3: COMMERCIAL TERMS

3.1 There are two commercial aspects involved in process of establishing the Advanced Robotic Control labs and skill development process through training of students and faculty.

- The process of lab establishment at the INDIAN UNIVERSITY will be funded 66.66 % by INDIAN UNIVERSITY AND 33.33% by GEMS and APS ECM.
 - INDIAN UNIVERSITY need to pay the 100% of their part of the payment within 10 working days after the MOU signing.
- Skill development aspect: Student training fund will be allocated as 45% by APSSDC (Andhra Pradesh Skill Development Corporation), 45% by ECM and 10% by student. Payment process terms with APSSDC defined in a separate agreement between APSSDC, APS ECM and Indian University.

With respect to the travel, accommodation and any other related expenses of the Indo-German faculties and students will be taken care by respective parties.

ARTICLE 4: CONFIDENTIALITY

Confidentiality - It is envisaged that the Parties or any members of their respective Groups or any of their respective Agents may from time to time disclose Confidential Information relating to its current or proposed business to each other. In consideration of such Confidential information being made available to all parties, the first party, the second party and the third party agree that any disclosure or dealings between the Parties will be subject to the terms and conditions of this Agreement. All Parties will treat and keep all Confidential Information confidential and will not, without the Disclosing Party's prior written consent, directly or indirectly communicate or disclose (whether in writing or orally or in any other manner) Confidential Information to any other person other than in accordance with the terms of this Agreement (for the avoidance of doubt, this will also prohibit discussing the same with any Disclosing Party Group employees other than those involved in connection with the Project).

- Nothing in this Agreement will constitute the creation of a partnership, joint venture or agency between the parties.
- Intellectual Property and Trademarks - Both the parties will continue with their respective trademarks including that of any improvements or work done at its own cost for this AGREEMENT.

ARTICLE 5: ANNOUNCEMENT

From the date of signature, all parties, can announce the existence of this MoU. All the parties can submit the MoU for any regulatory or Government related purposes.

All parties can announce about the MoU on its' website of ECMM and INDIAN UNIVERSITY can mention the others as resource partner on its Masters and Research Programs conducted with the help of Industry Partners.

ARTICLE 6: TERM AND TERMINATION

This MOU will also serve as a framework to describe Intel's relationship with the Institute and with FICE. Intel and FICE are independent contractors. FICE does not have any right or authority to assume or create any obligations on behalf of Intel or to bind Intel to any contract, agreement or undertaking with the Institute. Nothing in this MOU shall be

construed to create a partnership, joint venture, employment or agency relationship between Intel and FICE. Upon the execution of this MOU, Institute and FICE may discuss and negotiate the potential transaction(s) relating to the Program including setting up of lab in greater detail, which may include entering into binding agreements for the implementation of the Program.

2. Non-Binding Nature of this MOU: The Parties agree that this MOU is non-binding and the terms of this MOU are statements of intent only. This is not a binding agreement between the Parties except for the obligations provided under Sections 2 through 9 below, which are binding on the Parties. The Program is conducted by Intel on a non-binding basis. Intel has the right to cancel the Program and its related activities at any time at Intel's sole discretion without providing any reason to the Institute. No legally binding agreement shall exist until both parties have negotiated, prepared and executed separate individual written agreement(s) establishing the binding obligations of the Parties as approved by each Party's management and legal entities.
3. Confidentiality: Except as may be otherwise stated in MOU, or as may be required by law, the Parties agree that they shall seek and receive the express prior consent of the other Party before they disclose to the public or to any third party the existence of this MOU, any confidential information provided to each other or the relationship described herein.
4. Expenses: Institute will be responsible for its own expenses in connection with all matters relating to the Program. All monetary transactions for conducting the Program shall be between FICE and the Institute. There is no funding from Intel for FICE to carry out the objectives of or to implement the Program at the Institute. FICE will obtain its own funding from the Institute who wish to set up the state of the art Intel Intelligent Systems labs and implement the Program. In no event shall Intel be liable to the Institute for any fault, mismanagement, acts, omissions or damages of any kind whatsoever based upon or arising out of FICE's performance of or failure to carry out the Program activities as agreed with the Institute.
5. Non Exclusivity: Nothing in this MoU shall mean or shall be construed to mean that any of the Party is at any time precluded from having similar arrangements with any other person or third party, subject always to maintaining confidentiality obligations stated herein.
6. Limitation of Liability: In no event shall Intel have any liability to the Institute, students or any other third party, for any indirect, incidental, speculative, special or consequential damages, based upon the breach of contract, tort or otherwise, arising out of this MOU, or for the failure of FICE to ultimately complete the Program activities as agreed between FICE and the Institute.
7. Warranties Disclaimed: ALL DELIVERABLES, MATERIALS AND PROGRAM COLLATERALS, ETC.

PROVIDED BY INTEL ARE PROVIDED "AS IS" WITHOUT WARRANTY OF ANY KIND. INTEL SPECIFICALLY DISCLAIMS IMPLIED WARRANTIES OF MERCHANTABILITY AND FITNESS FOR A PARTICULAR PURPOSE AND ANY WARRANTY AGAINST INFRINGEMENT OF ANY INTELLECTUAL PROPERTY RIGHT OF ANY THIRD PARTY.

8. No Intellectual Property Rights Granted: This MOU does not grant the Institute any license or other rights to any trademarks, logos or other intellectual property of Intel, and use of any intellectual property of Intel will be governed by a separate license agreement.
9. Term and Termination: This MOU will continue in effect until it is terminated by one of the Parties. Either Party may terminate this MOU at any time for any or no reason upon 30 days' written notice to the other Party. In the event Intel cancels the Program and/or its related activities, this MOU shall stand automatically terminated and Intel may provide a written notice to the Institute to this effect. The obligation arising under Sections 2 to 10 of this MOU will survive termination.
10. Governing Law and Jurisdiction: This MOU will in all respects be governed by and construed in accordance with the laws of Republic of India. Each party hereby agrees to the sole jurisdiction of the courts of Bangalore for all disputes and litigation arising under or relating to this Agreement.
11. Independent Contractors: The Parties are independent contractors, and no agency, partnership, joint venture or employee-employer relationship is intended or created by this MOU. Neither Party will make any warranties or representations on behalf of the other.
12. Entire Understanding; Amendment; Assignment: This MOU sets forth the entire and final understanding and agreement of the Parties, and supersedes any and all oral or written agreements or understandings between the Parties, as to the subject matter hereof. No amendments or modifications shall be effective unless in writing and signed by authorized representatives of both Parties. The waiver of a breach of any provision of this MOU will not operate or be interpreted as a waiver of any other or subsequent breach. No right, duty or obligation under this MOU may be assigned, delegated, factored or subcontracted in any manner by either Party without the other Party's prior written consent, except that Intel may assign its rights or delegate its duties to one or more direct or indirectly-owned subsidiaries of Intel Corporation.

3. Minutes of meeting of the Selection Committee for the Selection of Centers for the AP-Skill Development Project held on 16.02.2016, AP. Secretariat, Hyderabad.

ORDER:

1. In the Government order 1st read above, the Government has issued orders for sanctioning the Project of SIEMENS Center of Excellence and Technical Skill Development Institutions and also accorded permission for entering into MoU with SIEMENS Company. As per the order, agreement has been executed between the APSSDC, SIEMENS and Design Tech Companies.
2. In the G.O. 2nd read above, the Government has issued orders for formation of committees to monitor and to track the proposal of implementation of the SIEMENS Project and also Centre Selection Committee.
3. As a sequel to the agreement entered with the SIEMENS and Design Tech Companies, meetings involving all the stakeholders have been held in the state sensitizing the institutions and presenting the significance and the requirements for starting SIEMENS Center of Excellence and Technical Skill Development Institutions.
4. Thereafter, as per the decision taken by the committees for selection of centers and monitoring the progress, applications (online) have been called for from the institutions / organizations and universities, duly notifying the same in the media, stipulating the last date for submission of application for expression of interest in order to operationalize the centers.
5. In the reference 3rd read above, i.e., on 16-02-2016, during the Selection Committee meeting for Selection of Centers for the "Andhra Pradesh- Skill Development Project " in the form of hub-spoke model is explained Six clusters were defined. These are territorial region roughly consisting of two – three district. They have been defined based on the supply side information in terms of population, number of institutions, and capacity of those institutions. Alignment of the clusters has been made with the proposed industrial development while keeping district also as a geographical unit. Each cluster will be one Centre of Excellence (COE) and five Technical Skill Development Institutes (TSDI).

6. Further, as decided by the committee, all the hosting institutions need to be inspected by a team of experts. Accordingly, teams have been constituted comprising members from Technical Education Department, Central Institute of Tools and Design, Hyderabad (an autonomous organization under of Government of India) and Jawaharlal Nehru Technological Universities (JNTUs), Kakinada and Anantapur to inspections have been carried out and inspection reports have been submitted.
7. Suitable criteria fixed for evaluation of the institutions and accordingly all the applications were graded and Universities and Engineering Colleges were evaluated using one set of criteria and also Polytechnics restricted one set of criteria. The ranked list of universities/colleges/institutions by cluster/district has been prepared and they have been evaluated with reference to the prescribed criteria. Finally, the committee constituted for the purpose of evaluation has recommended and approved the Colleges/ Institutions/ Organizations as Centre of Excellence (COE)/Technical Skill Development Institutions (TSDIs).
8. The Government after careful examination comprehensively, hereby orders that the institutions/ organizations/Universities as shown in the Annexure are selected as Siemens Centers of Excellence (6)/Technical Skill Development Institutions (36) subject to the following conditions:-
 - i) That the institutions will be subjected to further inspection by a team comprising members from SIEMENS and Design Tech.
 - ii) If found unsuitable due to restrictions and place, ability to accommodate 50% of capacity to outsiders, residential facilities to outsiders, another suitable institution, satisfying the conditions will be substituted.
 - iii) Selected institutions need to execute an agreement with Andhra Pradesh State Skill Development Corporation (APSSDC)
 - iv) Any contravention of the stipulated conditions as per MOU will disqualify the institution from hosting the COE or TSDI at any time and the Government has the right to replace the institution.
 - v) Operational guidelines shall be issued separately.
9. The Managing Director and Chief Executive Officer, Andhra Pradesh State Skill Development Corporation, Hyderabad shall take further necessary action.


